1) Approval of the Minutes of the 8th of July, 2010.

The minutes were approved.

2) Spokesman's Remarks

Alain reported on the MICE Project Board meeting. The board expressed cautious optimism regarding the experiment's plans (w/r to the SSs, etc), but wanted to see more detailed milestones that supported our advertised schedule.

Magnetic measurements: Evaluating a proposal from CERN and hope to move forward with it soon.

MICE Running. Alain stated that we need:

- a) MOM-chaired run coordination meeting when running
- b) Re-tune the MICO meeting
- c) Assign MICE sub-system point-of-contact

Manpower Issues. There will soon be many departures (some losses already) and MICE will have to address these as a collaboration. The MICE software & computing effort is being reorganized under David Colling, still need to finalize the definition of the Integration Physicist, need: a G4MICE detector leader (coordinate detector simulation effort), a production manager (running simulation configurations) and a Global Magnet Expert (GME). Finally, a new Editorial Board chair is needed.

3) PM Report

Andy gave a report summarizing status of scheduling update which would skip Step II, III.x and go directly to IV. He stressed the MPB Issues and the need for a DETAILED set of milestones and a schedule with a project complete date, or at the very least Step X complete dates. He also expressed concerns about the availability of STFC staff needed to meet MICE goals. Finally, he hoped that an updated visitor policy would be due out by Christmas.
